

Napa Valley Marathon Race Spectators

The Napa Valley Marathon boasts one of the most beautiful courses in the United States. The endless vineyards, early morning mist, and surrounding mountains are breathtaking. However, parking along these rural country roads is limited.

The CHP and local law enforcement have asked that all spectators park legally, do not block driveways or traffic lanes, and do not park on private property without the property owner's permission. Almost all of the crossroads that intersect the race course have deep ditches along the side of the road which makes legal parking difficult. Law Enforcement officials have been assigned to ensure the safety of all runners and drivers.

Following is a list of streets (from north to south) and parking availability:

Dunaweal Lane	Extremely limited
Larkmead Lane	Limited parking on one side of the road
Lodi Lane	Limited parking on one side of the road
Deer Park Road	Limited parking on both sides of the road
Pratt Avenue	Limited parking on both sides of the road
Pope Street	Lots of parking – the best place to watch
Zinfandel Lane	Limited parking on both sides of the road
Skellenger Lane (north)	No parking ½ mile to Silverado Trail on SR128
Skellenger Lane (south)	Limited parking on one side of the road
Oakville Crossroad	Parking on both sides of the road
Yountville Crossroad	No parking State Lane to Silverado Trail
Oak Knoll at Big Ranch Road	NO PARKING
Salvador at Big Ranch Road	NO PARKING
El Centro at Big Ranch Road	Extreme limited parking
